# **COVID-19 TABLETOP EXERCISE & GAP ANALYSIS REPORT 02/11/20**

# Scenario #1: Patient test positive while in quarantine Day 4

# Public Health Response

- Dr Vaimaila Salele: PH has 3 registrars plus Tagaloa and Leausa
  - Suspected case would be discussed with Tagaloa and Leausa for decision to swab
  - Notify lab to expect specimen
- Tagaloa Dr Robert Thomsen
  - POSITIVE CASE
    - Relocate case to Faleolo HC if stable/mild
      - Transport using NEOC vans
    - Entire passenger of flights will re-start another 14 days of quarantine
    - Refer to flight manifest to identify passengers seated 2 rows in front of, 2 rows behind of and 2 seats to either sides of index patient, for repeat of COVID-19 tests
    - Casual contacts, those in close proximity to index patient, including airport ground staff, drivers, and airline crew etc to be quarantined.
  - o Testing regime according to flight country of origin
    - NZ & Australia Test on Day 3 or 4 of quarantine and Day 14
    - Europe/USA/Asia- test on arrival at airport plus Day 3 and again on Day 14
  - Savaii lock down
    - MediVac flights and ferry transport available if needed
  - Gaualofa (Logistics):
    - When first positive case identified logistics will activate processes for welfare of staff (accommodation, meals, risk allowance, etc)
    - Reminded teams to submit any needs for covid preps (eg. medical equipment, etc)

- DDG CHS (Acting)
  - o Inform Dr Folototo, RN Natasha, RN Matilda
  - o Inform Logistics Gaualofa Matalavea
  - o Inform Dietetics Unit-Suafai Salima
  - Inform Securities
  - Inform Laundry Kristy Tyrell
- Patient transferred from Faleolo HC or Quarantine site via ambulance
  - Alpha team Nurse and Doctor to escort patient
- Logistics Gaualofa Matalavea

- One Positive Case in Samoa
- NEOC- National Level
  - Activate all 14 Government Sectors to assists MOH
  - Country Shut Down except wharf and cargo flights based on country needs
  - National Disaster Council activated- Chaired by Hon PM
  - Development Partners to assist
- Health Sector Level
  - Sector partners such as Red Cross, Family Health etc, mobilized to assist MOH
- Staff Accommodation for quarantine arranged.

#### Porters

- o 21 porters 8 porters allocated for COVID-19 patients
- Good attendance to COVID-19 prep trainings

### • Medical Records

- o Scanners mostly used to transfer patient information to doctors in COVID-19 ward
- o Specific Medical records staff have been allocated for COVID-19 patients
- o All MR offices in APCC, ED ground floor and level 2 will remain operational.
- Staff in COVID-19 areas will use appropriate PPEs and will be quarantined with other staff.
- If file is required by treating physician in COVID-19 ward, then zip-locked bags will be used to transport file.
- Dietetics unit food service
  - SOP prepared
- Laboratory
  - SOP prepared
  - o Morgue guidelines for COVID-19 related deaths not yet finalized.
