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<u>Process for obtaining Health Clearance for Food</u> handlers:

A. HEALTH CARD

- 1. Food handler must take the **Health Clearance** form and visit private clinic physician for a medical screening. (Fee for a doctor's visit depends on the clinic).
- 2. The doctor will conduct a medical screening for vital signs (refer to health clearance form).
- 3. Afterward, the doctor will provide 3 forms (2 Pathology specimen report forms & 1 X-ray form) to the food handler for laboratory & x-ray test at (TTM Hospital, Moto'otua or MTII Hospital).
- 4. At the laboratory, lab technicians will take 2 specimens from food handlers:
 - i. Stool for Salmonella Typhoid and Blood;
 - ii. Blood for Hepatitis A;

NOTE: X-ray test for Tuberculosis is conducted if it is required by the doctor.

- 5. The doctor will complete the health clearance based on analysis on the Pathology specimen report forms.
- 6. The private clinic will notify the food handler when to uplift health clearance forms and attached Pathology specimen report forms.
- 7. Food handler must submit the Health Clearance form and Pathology specimen report to the Food Safety office (Public Health Services, Motootua Old Maternity Ward) or MTII Tuasivi Hospital _ Food Safety Officer.
- 8. The Health Clearance form and Pathology specimen report will be reviewed by Public Health Doctor.

- 9. Food handler will be notified of the date to visit the Food Safety office and have their photos taken Upolu & Savaii.
- 10. The health card will be processed after the photo is taken and submitted to the Director General of Health for endorsement.
- 11. The Food Safety Office will notify the food handler when to uplift the health card and pay the \$10.00 fee.

B. <u>HEALTH CERTIFICATE</u> (Notice of Compliance)

Health Certificate – Food Businesses

- Complete the Health Certificate application form;
- 2. Submit the form to the Food Safety and Tobacco Control Unit;
- The Food Safety team will conduct a health inspection to determine if the application complies with Health Requirements;
